Chapter Rivals Program

2016-2017

- 1. The 2016-2017 Chapter Rivals Program will run from September 1^{st,} 2016, through June 30th. 2017.
- All required forms will be due to Dad Ray Lemons (<u>raymond.lemons@gmail.com</u>) and Dad Joey Schwartz (<u>carlschwrtz9@gmail.com</u>) electronically no later than the 10th of every month. All late forms will have their on-time bonus deducted from their total score. Forms can be sent to <u>rivals@michiganDemolay.org</u> or to the addresses listed above.
- 3. All point totals explained on the forms are final. *There will be no extras*.
- 4. All events observed for "DeMolay Month" and "Required Obligatory Days" will be taken note of and sent in a separate sheet for verification. Basically, the who, what, when, where, and why of the event.
- 5. In order for Degrees to count toward their point total, you must have an actual candidate. Protem candidates **DO NOT COUNT**.
- 6. The Rivals program for 2016-2017 does not recognize "Dual Membership"
- 7. Co-hosted chapter events/degrees will only count toward both chapters if and only if there is equal planning and participation form each chapter. Ex: Wayne/CCR co-host a degree, each chapter must have at least a chairman (active demolay) and one advisor during the planning process. Also, each chapter must *5 or more* to count toward the co-degree.

Visitation and State Galloping Gavels

- 1. Individual chapter gavels can only be won at chapter meetings and Installations.
- 2. The point total for a captured gavel will be 100pts. Capturing a gavel from or *your* rivals program will be 150pts.
- 3. Claiming an individual gavel takes *3 DeMolay's and 1 Advisor*. (All DeMolay and Advisors must be present and in the same room)
- 4. Claiming the State Galloping Gavel is a total of 125pts and can be won at the holder's chapter meetings and installations.
- Claiming the State Galloping Gavel takes 5 DeMolay's and 1 Advisor. (All DeMolay and Advisors must be present and in the same room)

- 6. In the event of a tie between **2** or more chapters, the chapter with the most Advisors will win. If a tie still occurs, the chapter traveling the most distance will win.
- 7. The State Galloping Gavel must be present at all Michigan DeMolay meetings.
- At the end of the year's program, the State Galloping Gavel and each Chapter Individual gavel must accompany the holder's chapter to Conclave to be disbursed.

Rival Chapters

- 1. Each chapter will be rivals with three other chapters located around the state based on the distance between one another.
- 2. As noted, participating in or during a rival chapters activity will result in double points, providing the instructions are followed that are listed on the forms.
- 3. Instructions dealing with gavels with a rival are explained in the above section.
- 4. Each chapters rivals are as follows:
 - a. *Chain of Lakes* Clio, Mt. Pleasant, Grand Rapids
 - b. *Grand Rapids* Chain of Lakes, Mt. Pleasant, Livingston County
 - c. *Mt. Pleasant* Chain of Lakes, Grand Rapids, Clio
 - d. Livingston County- Brotherhood, Grand Rapids, Mt. Pleasant
 - e. *River Raisin* C.C.R, Livingston County, Wayne
 - f. **Brotherhood** Livingston County, Clio, Davison
 - g. *Clio* Brotherhood, Davison, Chain of Lakes
 - h. *Davison* Phoenix, Port Huron, Brotherhood
 - i. *Port Huron* Roseville, Phoenix, Walt Disney
 - j. *Phoenix* Davison, Walt Disney, Port Huron
 - k. Roseville- Port Huron, C.C.R, Roseville
 - I. Walt Disney- Roseville, Wayne, C.C.R
 - m. Wayne- Walt Disney, River Raisin, Roseville
 - n. *C.C.R* River Raisin, Wayne, Phoenix
