MICHIGANDER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

RULES FOR APPLICATION

- You must belong to an Assembly of International Order of Rainbow for Girls, a Bethel of the International
 Order of Job's Daughters, or a Chapter of the International Order of DeMolay, in the state of Michigan. Please
 list the organization, how many years you have been a member, what offices you have held and any other
 pertinent information. You will need a signature of a Mother Advisor, Bethel Guardian or Dad Advisor.
- 2. The applicant <u>may</u> live out of the state of Michigan, but must be active in a youth group <u>that is within the state of Michigan</u> and plan to attend a college <u>within the state of Michigan</u>.
- 3. High school seniors and any full/part time post-secondary/undergraduate students may apply.
- 4. Applications must be completely filled out. Typewritten/electronic applications and statements are preferred over handwritten submissions. **The application must be signed.**
- 5. Include first semester transcript of grades. College students should include the most recent semester grades.

 Applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average base on a 4.0 system.
- 6. The applicant shall prepare an essay of more than 250 words and less than 300 words setting forth their vocational or professional goals. It should relate how past, present, and future activities make the foreseeable accomplishment of this goal possible. Additional criteria by which the applications will be judged are scholarship, leadership in school and non-school related activities (i.e. church, scouts, and youth organizations).
- 7. Two, but not more than three letters of recommendation are required. The letters must be signed and dated by the author and must cover the applicant's ability, work habits, leadership, personality, and integrity. (Letters from family/relatives will not be accepted.)
- 8. Applications MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MAY 1st of the current year, and mailed to the chairman of the scholarship of the Michigander Club.
- 9. Recipients will be notified in June of the Scholarships and a presentation will be made at Grand Assembly, Grand Bethel, and State Conclave.
- 10. A check from the Michigander Club for the amount of the Scholarship will be mailed to the Financial Aid *Office* or Registrar's Office on receipt of verification of enrollment from the student, who will also provide the address and their **Student I.D. Number.** This information will be sent to the Secretary of the Michigander Club.
- 11. Please give close attention to all of the required information and necessary attachments from other sources.
- 12. Your application with all attachments is to be sent to the chairman of the scholarship committee of the Michigander Club by **May 1**st.
